USA To Play For Gold Medal In Sydney

SYDNEY - The USA secured its spot in the Final at the 2022 FIBA Women's World Cup with a 83-43 triumph over Canada in the semifinals in Sydney.

The Americans led wire-to-wire and became the first nation to hold an opponent under 50 points in a World Cup semifinal.

The U.S. also set the record for largest margin of victory (40) in a semifinal (previously 36, USA defeated Spain 106-70 in 2010).

The U.S. improved to 7-1 all-time against Canada at the Women's World Cup.

Including tonight, the U.S. has won six consecutive against their neighbor to the north.

China defeated Australia 61-59 in the second semifinal.

FRESH FROM THE FINALS

Five athletes on the USA Basketball Women's National Team roster will join the team in Sydney after playing in the 2022 WNBA Finals. **Chelsea Gray** (WNBA Finals MVP), **Kelsey Plum** and **A'ja Wilson** head to Australia after winning the title for the Las Vegas Aces. From the runner-up Connecticut Sun will be **Brionna Jones** and **Alyssa Thomas**.

HOW WE GOT HERE

As the 2020 Olympic gold medalist, the USA was an automatic bid into the 2022 FIBA Women's World Cup. The other nation with an automatic entry was the host country, Australia. The remainder of the World Cup field competed in one of the four FIBA World Cup Qualifying Tournaments in February. The top three finishing teams in each of the four qualifying tournaments earned a bid into the 2022 FIBA World Cup.

The U.S. did compete in a Qualifying Tournament, going 2-0 with victories over Belgium (84-75) and Puerto Rico (93-55).

HEAD COACH CHERYL REEVE

On Dec. 8, 2021, Minnesota Lynx head coach and general manager **Cheryl Reeve**, who as an assistant coach for the USA Basketball Women's National Team helped the U.S. claim gold medals at the 2016 and 2020 Olympic Games and 2014 and 2018 FIBA World Cups, was named the USA National Team head coach through 2024.

In addition to USA National Team training camps and exhibition games, Reeve will lead the USA at the 2022 FIBA World Cup Qualifying Tournament in Washington, D.C.; the 2022 FIBA World Cup in Sydney, Australia; and, if the USA qualifies, the 2024 Olympic Games in Paris, France.

QUARTERFINAL QUALIFIERS

The USA is one of eight teams to qualify for the quarterfinals at the 2022 FIBA Women's World Cup. The U.S.'s all-time record against the remaining teams in a World Cup competition:

- Canada: **7-1** (USA defeated CAN, 83-43, on 9/30/22)

The USA will play in Group A at the 2022 FIBA Women's World Cup. The U.S.'s all-time record against Group A foes are:

- Bosnia & Herzegovina: **1-0** (USA defeated BIH, 121-59, on 9/27/22)

POSTGAME NOTES: USA vs. CAN (9/30/22)

It's Time for the Big One: The USA will play for its fourth consecutive FIBA Women's World Cup gold medal. In the last three World Cups, the U.S. defeated Australia (73-56 in 2018), Spain (77-64 in 2014) and Czech Republic (89-69 in 2010). The USA will play for a medal in 10 straight Women's World Cups (dating back to 1986). The U.S. is on a 29-game winning streak at the World Cup (dating back to 2006) with three gold medals during the streak (2010, 2014, 2018).

Danger Zone: The USA is 7-0 all-time against China at the Women's World Cup (dating back to 1983). The largest margin of victory was 47 points in 2006 (119-72) and the narrowest was 10 in 1983 (101-91 in overtime).

The U.S. and China played in the Group Phase earlier this week (9/24/22) with the Americans winning 77-63.

Having Any Fun Yet?: Several members of the USA roster will be play for another World Cup gold medal. Breanna Stewart will compete for her third while Jewell Loyd, Kelsey Plum and A'ja Wilson are looking for their second titles.

Let's Turn and Burn!: Canada was held scoreless for the first 4:51 of the game while the USA raced out to a 15-0 lead. The Americans shot 6-of-9 during that stretch while the Canadians were 0-for-9. The early lead for the U.S. marked the first time during the competition that Canada trailed by more than six points.

I Feel the Need, the Need for Speed: USA led 27-7 after the first quarter with Canada's seven points marking the second-lowest total to which the Americans held an opponent in a quarter this World Cup (Q3, 6, Puerto Rico on 9/23/22).

Great Balls of Fire: The U.S. shot 48.4% (31-64 FG) from the floor, 42.8% (6-14 3FG) from 3-point range and 88.2% (15-17 FT) from the line. Canada shot 21.9% (16-73 FG) from the field and 15.3% (4-26 3FG) from 3 and 87.5% (7-8 FT) at the charity stripe.

Your Reputation Precedes You, Captain: Shooting 4-of-5 from 3, Stewart set her World Cup career-high in 3-pointers. She had previously made no more than two in a game. Overall she finished with a game-high 17 points (6-11 FG), eight rebounds and three assists in 20 minutes.

D*mn This Kid is Good: Wilson, recording her first World Cup double-double, is the only American to score in double figures in each game she's played. Tonight she scored 15 points to go with 12 rebounds and three steals.

Take My Breath Away: Thomas was 5-for-5 to increase her shooting percentage for the World Cup to 67.3%. She finished with 10 points and three rebounds in 22 minutes for her sixth game in double-digits.

POSTGAME NOTES: USA vs. SRB (9/29/22)

Let's Ride: By advancing to the semifinals, the USA will play for a medal in 10 straight FIBA Women's World Cups (dating back to 1986). The U.S. is on a 28-game winning streak at the World Cup (dating back to 2006) with three gold medals during the streak (2010, 2014, 2018).

Like A Good Neighbor: The USA continues to share the ball, accounting for 23 assists on 28 field goals tonight. In six games, the U.S. has 165 assists on 235 made shots, a ratio of 70.2%.

It's In The Game: The USA crocheted together a series of stops at the end of the second quarter that carried into the third. The U.S. led 38-33 with 3:39 left in the second and the Americans held Serbia scoreless until the 5:15 mark of the third. Over that 8:24 of game time, the USA went on a 20-0 run to lead 58-33.

Just Do It: The U.S. shot 41.8% (28-67 FG) from the floor, 35.4% (11-31 3FG) from 3-point range and 91.3% (21-23 FT) from the line. Serbia shot 30.0% (21-70 FG) from the field and 25.0% (4-16 3FG) from 3 and 75.0% (9-12 FT) at the charity stripe.

Maybe She's Born With It: Picking up where she left off in the Group Phase, Thomas had another impressive effort. She scored 13 points (3-4 FG, 7-8 FT) to go with 14 rebounds, seven assists and three steals in 28 minutes. She has had four games with at least 10 points, seven rebounds, five assists and two steals at this competition.

Additionally, Thomas is the first player to record a 10+ points, 10+ rebounds and 5+ assists performance for the U.S. in a World Cup game since Maya Moore had 17 points, 14 rebounds and seven assists (vs. Serbia in 2014).

What Happens Here, Stays Here: Fresh off a WNBA Championship with the Las Vegas Aces, A'ja Wilson had her third game of 15-plus points. In 22 minutes tonight, the reigning WNBA MVP scored 15 points (5-7 FG) and pulled down eight rebounds.

They're Gr-r-r-eat!: The U.S. bench outscored Serbia's, 42-15. Kelsey Plum had a game-high 17 points as a reserve while Sabrina Ionescu and Ariel Atkins each chipped in seven. The USA is averaging 48.3 bench points per game at the World Cup.

POSTGAME NOTES: USA vs. BIH (9/27/22)

Success in Successive Succession: The USA broke its record for consecutive wins at the World Cup by winning the 27th straight today. The previous streak of 26 occurred 1994-2006 while the current streak began in 2006.

Quay Up the Quarterfinals: With a 5-0 record in Group A, the USA secured the top spot in their group and qualified for the quarterfinals. The FIBA Women's World Cup Quarterfinals Draw will take place at the conclusion of the Group Phase on September 27.

Buckets, Bench & Break: Entering the game, the U.S. averaged 52.0% shooting, 46.8 bench points and 22.0 fastbreak points per contest. Those averages will grow with the USA shooting 65.8%, combining for 61 points off the bench and tallying 36 fastbreak points.

Pack-a-Punch: The U.S. shot 65.8% (52-79 FG) from the floor, 50.0% (8-16 3FG) from 3-point range and 81.8% (9-11 FT) from the line. Bosnia and Herzegovina shot 40.3% (25-62 FG) from the field and 25.8% (8-31 3FG) from 3 and 100% (1-1 FT) at the charity stripe.

Today's Terrific Trio: The leading scorer for the U.S. was Kelsey Plum who had 20 points (8-11 FG) to go with seven assists. Chelsea Gray was not far behind with 16 points (5-7 FG) and seven assists. Captain Breanna Stewart added 15 points (7-11 FG) and seven rebounds as well.

Sunshine in Sydney: The U.S. benefited from the output from the Connecticut Sun duo of Brionna Jones and Alyssa Thomas. Jones (14 points, five rebounds) has scored at least 10 points in each of the last three games at the competition. Thomas' five rebounds today (6.0 RPG) gave her 30 total in the Group Phase, including a team-best 10 offensive.

More Mystics Magic: The duo from DC continue help the USA. Shakira Austin scored 10-plus points for the third time with a 15 point performance. Ariel Atkins was a steady hand with her third game of 5-plus assists as she had five to go

with three steals.

POSTGAME NOTES: USA vs. KOR (9/26/22)

The One Where the USA Made History: With 145 points scored over Korea, the U.S. set a FIBA World Cup record. The previous record was 143 points set by Brazil in 1990. The U.S.'s previous scoring records was 119, which was done on two occasions (vs. Angola on 9/30/14; vs. China 9/12/06).

The scoring mark came via 62-of-94 shooting by the USA. The 62 shots made surpassed the U.S.'s previous record of 47 (vs. Korea on 6/2/94).

The Americans set their single-game assists record (36) too. The previous USA best was 32 (vs. Angola on 9/30/14; vs. South Korea 6/2/94).

Additionally, the USA has won 26 straight games at the Women's World Cup, matching the nation's longest winning streak at the competition. The previous streak of 26 occurred 1994-2006 while the current streak began in 2006.

We Were on a Break!: The USA scored above their average for fastbreak points tonight. Entering the game, the U.S. averaged 21.7 fastbreak points per game with Americans scoring 23, including 15 in the first half, against Korea. The success in transition came via defensive pressure, which resulted in 20 Korean turnovers.

The Routine: Entering tonight's game, the U.S. was shooting 48% (72-149 2FG) on two-point field goals. Against Korea, the USA shot 69.3%, highlighted by an impressive 88 points in the paint (entered averaging 42.0).

How You Doin'?: The U.S. shot 66.0% (62-94 FG) from the floor, 52.6% (10-19 3FG) from 3-point range and 64.7% (11-175 FT) from the line. Korea shot 43.1% (31-72 FG) from the field and 29.2% (7-24 3FG) from 3 but did not attempt a free throw.

Oh! My! God!: The U.S. had eight players score in double figures, including two 20-plus point scorers in Brionna Jones (game-high 24) and A'ja Wilson (20). Joining the front-court duo were Kelsey Plum (19), Breanna Stewart (18), Shakira Austin (16), Betnijah Laney (13), Kahleah Copper (11) and Alyssa Thomas (10).

Could She Be Any More MVP?: Less than six minutes in, Wilson scored her ninth and 10th points of the game on a layup. The reigning two-time WNBA MVP started 8-for-8 for the game to finish with 20 points (10-11 FG) and eight rebounds in 15 minutes.

The last time an American made 6-plus field goals without a miss was Nneka Oguwumike (vs. Senegal, 9/22/18) when she went 6-of-6 en route to 16 points.

I'll Be There for You: The U.S. outrebounded Korea 56-20. The USA had four players pull down at least eight boards, including Austin (8), Jones (8), Thomas (8) and Wilson (8). Thomas and Wilson have at least rebounds in back-to-back games.

POSTGAME NOTES: USA vs. CHN (9/24/22)

It's a Long Way to the Top: Entering the game, China was leading all World Cup teams with a 102.5 points per game average. The USA held China to 63 points and 41.0% shooting from the field. China was held to 16-or-less points in three of the four quarters.

Thunderstruck: Like the World Cup opener against Belgium, the U.S. had a quick start in tonight's game. Scoring the first 11 points of the game, the Americans held China scoreless for the first 2:43 of the game. Another pivotal run (13-0) for the USA came in the final 3:50 in the second quarter.

Highway to Help: The USA had 18 assists on 28 baskets. For the competition, they have 71 on 93 buckets (assist-to-FGM ratio of 76%). Meanwhile, the three U.S. opponents have a combined 46 assists.

Shoot to Thrill: The U.S. shot 39.0% (28-72 FG) from the floor, 37.0% (7-19 3FG) from 3-point range and 93.0% (14-15 FT) from the line. China shot 41.0% (25-61 FG) from the field, 47.0% (7-15 3FG) from three and 100.0% (6-6 FT) from the line.

Back in Black: The U.S. roster was at full strength for the first time this competition with the additions of the Las Vegas Aces trio of Chelsea Gray (12 points, six rebounds), Kelsey Plum (eight points) and A'ja Wilson (20 points, eight rebounds). The recent WNBA champions combined for 40 of the USA's 77 points.

High Voltage: The first American to score in double figures was Alyssa Thomas, who finished the night with 12 points, eight rebounds, five assists and five steals. Thomas has at least two steals in each game of the competition thus far for a total of 13.

POSTGAME NOTES: USA vs. PUR (9/23/22)

I Like It! Another!: The U.S. accounted for 10 of their 13 steals in the first half. The USA had 11 in their opener against Belgium. A defensive menace, Thomas had six steals in the game (eight total through two games). The U.S. individual record for steals in a game is seven by Cheryl Miller (vs. Hungary in 1996), but Thomas' six were the most since Tamika Catchings (6 vs. Russia in 2002).

I Knew It: The USA continue to share the ball, racking up 28 assists on 35 field goals made. Against Belgium, the U.S. had 25 assists to 30 baskets. For the entire competition, the assist-to-FGM ratio is 82% (53-65).

That's What Heroes Do: The U.S. shot 54.0% (35-65 FG) from the floor, 41.0% (7-17 3FG) from 3-point range and 78.0% (29-37 FT) from the line. Puerto Rico shot 21.0% (13-63 FG) from the field, 17.0% (4-24 3FG) from three and 80.0% (12-15 FT) from the line.

What Do We Have Here?: The U.S. scored 47 points off the bench tonight, led by Austin's double-double of 19 points and 10 rebounds. Jones nearly had a double-double as well, finishing with 15 points and nine rebounds as a reserve.

I Went For The Lead: A Copper free throw with 6:21 remaining in the second quarter put the USA ahead 34-11. The 23-point margin surpassed the largest advantage the U.S. held against Belgium (22). The American lead would balloon to as many as 64 tonight as Copper finished with 16 points, four rebounds and four assists.

Friends From Work: Teammates on the WNBA's Seattle Storm, the duo of Loyd (12) and Stewart (11) combined for 20-plus points against Puerto Rico on a combined 6-for-12 shooting. In the game against Belgium, Loyd (14) and Stewart (22) combined for 28 points.

POSTGAME NOTES: USA vs. BEL (9/22/22)

Just Keep Swimming: The USA held Belgium scoreless for the first three minutes of the game and jumped to a quick 12-0 lead. Ariel Atkins scored the first World Cup basket for the U.S. on their first possession via a jump shot at the free throw line. The Americans did not trail in the game.

Mine! Mine! Mine!: The U.S. forced 25 Belgium turnovers in the game with 14 of them coming in the first half. As a result, the Americans scored 27 points off the Belgian miscues (10 in the first half).

Hot Shot: The U.S. shot 45.6% (30-66 FG) from the floor, 38.9% (7-18 3FG) from 3-point range and 87.0% (20-23 FT) from the line. Belgium shot 44.3% (27-61 FG) from the field, 40.7% (11-27 3FG) from three and 70.0% (7-10 FT) from the line.

You So Totally Rock: It was an impressive performance for Thomas, after joining the U.S. in Sydney Wednesday due to the WNBA Finals. In 28 minutes, the forward flirted with a triple-double by recording 14 points (6-10 FG), nine assists and seven rebounds.

Thank Youuuuuu: Stewart, USA's captain, was the offensive catalyst tonight. In addition to scoring a game-high 22 points on 8-for-18 shooting, she nearly set a new career-high for points in a World Cup game (23 vs. China on 9/23/18). She also had four rebounds, three assists, three steals and three blocks.

Assists are Friends: Playing with pace, the USA had 25 assists on 30 made baskets. Leading the way with a game-high nine dimes was Thomas. Atkins added six in the game. Eight of the nine Americans in the game recorded at least one assist.
